6 For an Act entitled: "An Act adding amendments to statutory references to
7 The National Health Planning and Resources Development
8 Act of 1974 (P.L. 93-641); and providing for an effec-
9 tive date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 18.07.011 is amended to read:

12 Sec. 18.07.011. STATEWIDE HEALTH COORDINATING COUNCIL. There is
13 created the Statewide Health Coordinating Council. The council shall be
14 organized in the manner described by sec. 1524(b), P.L. 93-641 as amended
15 by P.L. 96-79 and P.L. 97-35, sec. 237(a)(1)(A), P.L. 94-63 and AS 47.-
16 30.605(a). The council shall perform the functions listed in
17 sec. 1524(c), P.L. 93-641 as amended by P.L. 96-79 and P.L. 97-35,
18 sec. 237(a)(1)(A), P.L. 94-63 and AS 47.30.605(b).

19 * Sec. 2. AS 18.07.021 is amended to read:

20 Sec. 18.07.021. STATE HEALTH PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT AGENCY. The
21 office of planning and research in the department is the state health
22 planning and development agency designated under sec. 1521(b)(3),
23 P.L. 93-641 as amended by P.L. 96-79 and P.L. 97-35. The office shall
24 perform the functions enumerated under sec. 1523, P.L. 93-641 as amended
25 by P.L. 96-79 and P.L. 97-35, administer the certificate of need program
26 outlined in AS 18.07.041 - 18.07.111, and other functions prescribed in
27 this chapter.

28 * Sec. 3. AS 18.07.111(5) is amended to read:

29 (5) "council" means the Statewide Health Coordinating Council

2 amended by P.L. 96-79 and P.L. 97-35;

4 (9) "health systems agency" means an entity organized and
5 operated in accordance with sec. 1521(b), P.L. 93-641 as amended by
6 P.L. 96-79 and P.L. 97-35, engaging in health planning and development
7 functions in a specified health service area of the state;

8 * Sec. 5. AS 18.26.030(a)(4)(A) is amended to read:

9 (A) each health systems agency in the state, organized
10 and operated in accordance with sec. 1512, P.L. 93-641 as amended
11 by P.L. 96-79 and P.L. 97-35, which shall submit three nominees
12 from among the members of that agency;

13 * Sec. 6. AS 47.30.475(b) is amended to read:

14 (b) Money available under this section shall be awarded by the
15 department to applicants on the basis of community need, but only if the
16 award is consistent with the annual implementation plan developed under
17 sec. 1513(b)(2) of P.L. 93-641 as amended by P.L. 96-79 and P.L. 97-35
18 by the health systems agency for the health system area in which the
19 applicant is located and the state health plan developed by the State-
20 wide Health Coordinating Council under sec. 1524(c)(2)(A) of P.L. 93-641
21 as amended by P.L. 96-79 and P.L. 97-35, and only after consideration of
22 comment and advice of the Advisory Board on Alcoholism. In awarding
23 grants, the department shall further consider the amount of money that
24 is available for all applications and whether an application would
25 contribute to the wise development of a comprehensive program of alco-
26 holic rehabilitation and prevention.
