2 SENATE BILL NO. 767

5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the membership of the Alaska Com-
7 mission on Postsecondary Education."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 *Section 1. AS 14.40.903(a)(4) is amended to read:

10 (4) four [FIVE] persons broadly and equitably representative
11 of the general public appointed by the governor;

12 * Sec. 2. AS 14.40.903(a) is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

13 (8) one person appointed in accordance with (e) of this
14 section who is a full-time student as defined in the University of
15 Alaska Academic Regulations.

16 * Sec. 3. AS 14.40.903 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

17 (e) A student shall be appointed to the Alaska Commission on Post-
18 secondary Education from a list of nominees submitted to the governor.
19 The governor shall make his appointment from the list within 60 days
20 after it is submitted to him. The list shall consist of the names of
21 two students from each campus of the University of Alaska after an
22 election is held at each campus. Elections shall be conducted under
23 rules established by the Office of the Governor. The term of office of
24 the member of the commission appointed from the general student body,
25 University of Alaska, is for two years. The governor shall appoint a
26 successor from those students appearing on the list of nominees within
27 60 days after a vacancy in the office to serve for the unexpired term of
28 the original appointee. Notwithstanding (c) of this section, a student
29 appointee is not subject to confirmation by the legislature. The term

1 "campus" used in this subsection means a portion of the University of
2 Alaska designated as a "campus" by the Board of Regents.

3 * Sec. 4. Persons appointed under AS 14.40.903(a)(4) and serving on the
4 Alaska Commission on Postsecondary Education on the effective date of this
5 Act continue to serve until their terms expire. The first person appointed
6 under AS 14.40.903(a)(4) whose term expires after the effective date of this
7 Act shall be replaced with a full-time student appointed under AS 14.40.903-
8 (a)(8).
