For an Act entitled: "An Act making a special appropriation to the Department of Education for upgrading Bureau of Indian Affairs educational facilities to meet state codes; and providing for an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. FINDINGS. The Legislature finds that it is detrimental to
12 the delivery of educational services in Alaska to have a dual educational
13 system of State and Bureau of Indian Affairs schools. Further, the Legisla-
14 ture finds that schools operated by the Bureau of Indian Affairs badly need
15 upgrading and renovation. Therefore, as an incentive to facilitate transfer
16 of the Bureau of Indian Affairs schools to State ownership, the Legislature
17 appropriates \$35,000,000 for the purpose of upgrading those facilities sub-
18 sequent to transfer.

* Sec. 2. The sum of \$35,000,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Education to be allocated to upgrade Bureau of Indian Affairs schools on a first-come, first-serve basis after their transfer to State ownership.
