6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the practice of dentistry; continu-  
7 ing the existence of the Board of Dental Examiners; and  
8 providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

14 Sec. 08.36.280. TEMPORARY PERMIT. (a) The board may issue a [ONE  
15 YEAR] temporary permit [WITHOUT EXAMINATION] to a person who applies  
16 for a license [AN APPLICANT] to practice dentistry in the state if [IN A  
17 LOCALITY REQUESTED BY THE APPLICANT IF THE LOCALITY IS OF THE TYPE  
18 SPECIFIED IN (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION AND] the applicant

19 (1) meets the requirements of AS 08.36.110;

20 [(2) DESIRES TO PRACTICE DENTISTRY IN A CITY OR RURAL VILLAGE  
21 WHICH DOES NOT HAVE A RESIDENT LICENSED DENTIST IN ACTIVE GENERAL PRAC-  
22 TICE;

23 (3) HAS A LICENSE IN GOOD STANDING TO PRACTICE DENTISTRY IN A  
24 STATE, TERRITORY, DISTRICT OR POSSESSION OF THE UNITED STATES;]

25 (4) [TENDERS AND] pays the fee prescribed in AS 08.36.290(9)  
26 [AS 08.36.290(6)].

27 [(b) THE BOARD MAY AUTHORIZE A TEMPORARY PERMITTEE TO PRACTICE  
28 DENTISTRY IN MORE THAN ONE CITY OR RURAL VILLAGE OF THE TYPE SPECIFIED  
29 IN (a)(2) OF THIS SECTION.

1 (c) THE BOARD MAY ANNUALLY RENEW A TEMPORARY PERMIT UPON WRITTEN  
2 APPLICATION OF AN APPLICANT AND UPON PAYMENT OF THE PRESCRIBED FEE IF  
3 THE APPLICANT HAS NOT COMMITTED AN ACT WHICH IS A GROUND FOR REVOCATION  
4 IN AS 08.36.310, BUT IN ANY CASE, WITHIN TWO YEARS FROM ISSUANCE OF HIS  
5 FIRST TEMPORARY PERMIT, THE APPLICANT MUST PASS A BOARD EXAM.]

6 (d) A temporary permit may be revoked, suspended or annulled, or  
7 the permittee may be reprimanded, censured or disciplined by the board  
8 in the same manner and for the same cause as a licensed dentist under  
9 AS 08.36.310.

10 (e) The board shall grant or deny an application for a temporary  
11 permit within 60 days after it is received.

12 (f) A temporary permit issued under (a) of this section is valid  
13 until the results of the examination following the issuance of the  
14 temporary permit are published.

15 (g) A holder of a temporary permit issued under (a) of this sec-  
16 tion may practice dentistry only under the direct supervision of a  
17 dentist licensed under this chapter.
