6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to insurance provisions in state
7 construction contracts; and providing for an effective
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 36 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

11 CHAPTER 94. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS.

12 AS 36.94.001. INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS IN CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS.

13 (a) In requesting bids and awarding state construction contracts an
14 instrumentality of the state, may not require a contractor to obtain
15 workers' compensation, general liability, or other required insurance
16 from a particular insurer, agent, or broker and may not agree to provide
17 insurance to a contractor who is awarded a contract under this section.

18 (b) As used in this section "instrumentality of the state" means a
19 state department or agency, whether in the legislative, judicial or
20 executive branch, including such agencies as the Alaska Power Authority,
21 the University of Alaska, and the Alaska State Housing Authority.

22 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
23 070(c).
