1 IN THE SENATE BY THE FINANCE COMMITTEE
2 CS FOR SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 9 (Finance)
3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
4 TWELFTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Establishing a joint committee of
6 the Twelfth Legislature relating to
7 the organization and procedures of a
8 state constitutional convention.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 WHEREAS the Eleventh Legislature appropriated money for the work of a
11 joint committee established to examine the organization and procedures of
12 the Constitutional Convention of 1955-1956, matters relating to implementing
13 a call for a constitutional convention, and issues which could arise at a
14 constitutional convention, with the purpose of preparing guidelines and
15 recommendations for conducting a future constitutional convention; and

16 WHEREAS, during 1982, the voters of Alaska will be asked to vote again
17 on the question "Shall there be a Constitutional Convention?", making the
18 work of the joint committee on the constitutional convention timely and
19 invaluable; and

20 WHEREAS the joint committee has voted unanimously that the work of the
21 committee should continue until the voters have an opportunity to vote
22 during 1982 on whether a constitutional convention shall be held;

23 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that a joint committee
24 of the Twelfth Legislature is established to examine matters pertaining to
25 the organization and conduct of constitutional conventions in Alaska; and be
26 it

27 FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee consists of five senators appointed
28 by the president of the senate and five representatives appointed by the
29 speaker of the house of representatives; and be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED that the person or persons who chair the committee
2 shall be chosen in a manner that is agreeable to the president of the senate
3 and speaker of the house of representatives; and be it

4 FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee has authority to meet during and
5 between sessions of the legislature, shall be dissolved January 10, 1983,
6 and shall submit its final report to the First Session of the Thirteenth
7 Legislature not later than January 25, 1983.
