2 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 34

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 TWELFTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to World Food Day.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS hunger and chronic malnutrition are daily facts of life for
8 hundreds of millions of people throughout the world; and

9 WHEREAS children suffer the most serious effects of hunger and malnutri-
10 tion; and

11 WHEREAS a major global food shortage appears likely within the next two
12 decades; and

13 WHEREAS the problem of hunger in the world threatens the security of
14 the United States; and

15 WHEREAS the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations has
16 designated October 16, 1981, as World Food Day to alert the people of the
17 world to this increasingly dangerous situation;

18 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests
19 the Governor to designate October 16, 1981, as World Food Day in Alaska and
20 calls upon the people of Alaska to observe this day with appropriate activi-
21 ties.
