5 Relating to the use of computers and
6 telecommunications systems.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the United States is rapidly evolving into an information society
9 in which the role of computers and telecommunications is increasingly signifi-
10 cant; and

11 WHEREAS computers and telecommunication technology offer unusual oppor-
12 tunities for fraud and theft by those who have technological knowledge; and

13 WHEREAS unauthorized access to and the interconnection of computers and
14 telecommunication systems presents a serious threat to the right of privacy
15 and the civil liberties of the public in general; and

16 WHEREAS the law concerning the permissible uses of computers and tele-
17 communications technology and the protection of the originators and owners of
18 programs used in those technologies is unclear;

19 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Governor is
20 respectfully requested to propose a comprehensive and detailed revision of
21 Alaska law on the use of computers and telecommunication systems to be sub-
22 mitted to the First Session of the Thirteenth Legislature.
