2 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 29
3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
4 TWELFTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Requesting the United States Postal
6 Service to construct a new post
7 office building for Dillingham.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the Dillingham Post Office presently occupies an old building
10 which does not provide sufficient space to meet the needs of the postal
11 customers in the area; and

12 WHEREAS to date efforts of various community and civic groups and
13 leaders have not succeeded in bringing about the construction of a new post
14 office facility; and

15 WHEREAS the maintenance of adequate postal facilities is of particular
16 significance in the more remote areas of the state which depend heavily on
17 the postal system for information and goods;

18 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests
19 the United States Postal Service to undertake the acquisition or construc-
20 tion of a new post office for the Dillingham area.
