2 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 37

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 TWELFTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to construction of the  
6 Bradley Lake hydroelectric project.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the United States Army Corps of Engineers is completing a  
9 general design memorandum on the Bradley Lake hydroelectric project; and

10 WHEREAS the Army Corps of Engineers is requesting authorization and  
11 funding from the United States Congress to begin construction of the Bradley  
12 Lake hydroelectric project; and

13 WHEREAS the Alaska Power Authority would like work to begin on the  
14 Bradley Lake hydroelectric project as early as possible; and

15 WHEREAS the Bradley Lake hydroelectric project is an economically,  
16 environmentally, and technically feasible renewable energy project which  
17 should be constructed as early as possible;

18 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests  
19 the United States Congress to consider the general design memorandum prepared  
20 by the Army Corps of Engineers, to request the issuance of a license from  
21 the federal Energy Regulatory Commission for the Bradley Lake hydroelectric  
22 project, and to authorize the construction of that project.
