2 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 38

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 TWELFTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Requesting Congress to appropriate
6 money to the Small Business Adminis-
7 tration as authorized in P.L. 93-237.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS in 1974 Congress enacted P.L. 93-237 (87 Stat. 1023) entitled
10 "An Act to amend the Small Business Act"; and

11 WHEREAS P.L. 93-237 amends the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C.A. sec.
12 633) to increase the total amount of loans, guarantees, and other obligations
13 and commitments outstanding by the Small Business Administration; and

14 WHEREAS P.L. 93-237 represents neither an appropriation of money nor an
15 authorization for appropriations but rather merely allows the Small Business
16 Administration to increase its loan ceilings so that it may spend money that
17 it will obtain through the appropriation process or through repayment of
18 prior loans; and

19 WHEREAS Congress has failed to appropriate money to the Small Business
20 Administration which permits it to fully implement its higher lending author-
21 ity authorized by P.L. 93-237; and

22 WHEREAS the development of and assistance to small businesses is im-
23 portant to the economy of the state;

24 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests
25 Congress to appropriate the money necessary to fully implement P.L. 93-237.

26 COPIES of this resolution shall be sent to the Honorable Mark O.
27 Hatfield, Chairman of the Senate Appropriations Committee; the Honorable
28 Jamie L. Whitten, Chairman of the House Appropriations Committee; and to the
29 Honorable Ted Stevens and the Honorable Frank Murkowski, U.S. Senators, and

1 the Honorable Don Young, U.S. Representative, members of the Alaska delega-
2 tion in Congress.
