2 HOUSE CS FOR SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 75 (Judiciary)  
3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA  
4 TWELFTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION  
5 Relating to martial law in Poland.  
6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:  
7 WHEREAS the people of Poland are currently living under martial law  
8 imposed on them by their government; and  
9 WHEREAS martial law by its nature represses the ability of the people of  
10 Poland to determine their destiny; and  
11 WHEREAS all of the people of the world who are free or who yearn to be  
12 free feel sympathy for the people of Poland who are being repressed by force;  
13 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the legislature  
14 supports the people of Poland in their efforts toward self-determination; and  
15 be it  
16 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature condemns the actions  
17 of the Polish Government in repressing the people of Poland through the  
18 establishment of martial law; and be it  
19 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature supports the United  
20 States Government in its efforts to assist the people of Poland in their  
21 quest for freedom.  
22 COPIES of this resolution shall be sent to the Honorable Ronald R.  
23 Reagan, President of the United States; the Honorable George Bush, Vice-  
24 President of the United States and President of the U.S. Senate; the Honorable  
25 Thomas P. O'Neill, Jr., Speaker of the U.S. House of Representatives; the  
26 Honorable Alexander Haig, U.S. Secretary of State; and to the Honorable Ted  
27 Stevens and the Honorable Frank Murkowski, U.S. Senators, and the Honorable  
28 Don Young, U.S. Representative, members of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
