5 Relating to the inauguration of  
6 Ronald Reagan and George Bush.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

8 WHEREAS Ronald Wilson Reagan and George Herbert Walker Bush captured  
9 489 electoral votes, including Alaska's three electoral votes, in their  
10 victory in the November 1980 election for President and Vice President of  
11 the United States; and

12 WHEREAS Ronald Reagan, as former Governor of California brings to the  
13 office of the President an understanding of and sympathy for the problems of  
14 Western States; and

15 WHEREAS Ronald Reagan and George Bush, both having visited this state,  
16 recognize Alaska's important role in the future of the United States and the  
17 world; and

18 WHEREAS Ronald Reagan and George Bush offer the prospect of better  
19 relations between the State of Alaska and the federal government;

20 BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Alaska State Senate extends its official con-  
21 gratulations to President-elect Ronald Reagan and Vice President-elect  
22 George Bush; and be it

23 FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the members representing the Alaska State Senate  
24 at the inauguration are requested to personally deliver this resolution to  
25 President Ronald Reagan and Vice President George Bush during Inaugural Week  
26 in Washington, D.C.
