mittee on the Alaska Railroad.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

WHEREAS the federal government desires to relinquish ownership of the  
9 Alaska Railroad; and

10

WHEREAS state control of the Alaska Railroad is one of the possible  
11 alternatives under consideration; and

WHEREAS the Alaska delegation in Congress has emphasized that it is  
13 important for the state to designate a person or entity that has authority  
14 to enter into discussions with the federal government concerning the transfer  
15 of the Alaska Railroad; and

16

WHEREAS the Alaska delegation in Congress has also stated that time is  
17 of the essence in participating in negotiations for the transfer of the  
18 Alaska Railroad;

BE IT RESOLVED that a Senate Special Committee on the Alaska Railroad  
20 is established to represent the Senate in any negotiations relating to the  
21 transfer of the Alaska Railroad from federal ownership; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the president of the Senate appoint three members  
23 of the Senate to serve on the Senate Special Committee on the Alaska Railroad  
24 and designate the chairman of the committee.
