9 Ziegler, Sr.

10 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

11 WHEREAS, on Friday, May 28, Senator Robert Ziegler collapsed on the
12 Senate floor; and

13 WHEREAS, within seconds of Senator Ziegler's collapse legislative aide
14 McKie Campbell and security guard Bobby Carroll were engaged in administrating
15 cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) to the Senator; and

16 WHEREAS legislative aides Glen Svendsen and Russ Josephson also came
17 promptly to the Senator's assistance and participated in the CPR effort; and

18 WHEREAS these individuals continued their efforts until joined by
19 emergency medical technicians (EMT's) from the Juneau Fire Department who
20 continued treatment as part of the Medic I program under the direction of Dr.
21 Henry Akiyama; and

22 WHEREAS, the Medic I program is conducted under the direction of an
23 advisory board consisting of doctors, nurses and hospital staff and greatly
24 increases chances of survival, but success of the program is directly
25 contingent on the general public's skill and knowledge of CPR techniques; and

26 WHEREAS the knowledge of these techniques was available when needed
27 because McKie Campbell acquired emergency medical training as a former law
28 enforcement officer in addition to instructing scuba-diving, Glenn Svendsen
29 was a medic in the U.S. Army, and Russ Josephson is an EMT graduate; and

1 WHEREAS the expertise of these individuals and the assistance of security
2 guard Bobby Carroll, coupled with the prompt and efficient administering of
3 advanced emergency medical techniques by the Juneau Fire Department, prevented
4 possible complications for the Senator;

5 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate that gratitude, appreciation, and commenda-
6 tion are extended to McKie Campbell, Bobby Carroll, Glenn Svendsen, and Russ
7 Josephson for the teamwork exhibited in a crisis situation in the Alaska
8 Senate.
