EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 56

1
2 Under the authority of art. III, sec. 23, of the Alaska Constitution,
3 and in accordance with AS 24.30.130(b), I order the following:

4 * Section 1. As governor, I find that it would be in the best interests
5 of efficient administration to transfer from the Department of Adminis-
6 tration to the Department of Education the responsibility for distributing
7 the session laws and the Alaska Statutes.

8 * Sec. 2. AS 24.35.010(c) is amended to read:

9 (c) The Legislative Affairs Agency is responsible for arranging
10 for the production, editing, publishing and distribution of the laws
11 of each session. The executive director shall have the slip law
12 copies of the enrolled acts produced in sufficient quantity for one
13 complete set to be provided each legislator pending the publication of
14 supplements to the Alaska Statutes. The commissioner of education
15 [ADMINISTRATION] is to receive sufficient copies of the slip laws for
16 official state distribution and he may charge for other distribution
17 on the basis of production and handling costs.

18 * Sec. 3. AS 24.35.020(a) is amended to read:

19 (a) The Department of Education [ADMINISTRATION] is responsible
20 for making official distribution of the Alaska Statutes to state
21 agencies. Distribution shall be made on the basis of written requests
22 and justifications submitted by the executive officer of each agency
23 to the Legislative Affairs Agency and approved by the executive direc-
24 tor of the Legislative Affairs Agency. A legislator is entitled to
25 receive one set of the statutes for his personal use, and this enti-
26 tlement is restricted to the one set issued during a member's entire
27 legislative service. The commissioner of education [ADMINISTRATION]
28 may deposit one set of the statutes in each free public library within
29 the state. The right of sale to persons and organizations remains
