For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to insurance requirements in state
8 construction projects; and providing for an effective
9 date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section. 1. AS 36.90 is amended by adding a new section to read:

12 Sec. 36.90.005. INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS IN CONSTRUCTION CON-
13 TRACTS. (a) In requesting bids and awarding state construction
14 contracts an instrumentality of the state may not require a contractor
15 to obtain workers' compensation, general liability, or other required
16 insurance from a particular insurer, agent, or broker and may not
17 agree to provide insurance to a contractor who is awarded a state
18 construction contract.

19 (b) As used in this section "instrumentality of the state" means
20 a state department or agency in the legislative, judicial, or execu-
21 tive branch, and includes such agencies as the Alaska Power Authority,
22 the University of Alaska, and the Alaska State Housing Authority.

23 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.-
24 10.070(c).
