A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act repealing the permanent fund dividend pro-
7 gram; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 43.23 is repealed.

10 * Sec. 2. Section 26, ch. 102, SLA 1982 is repealed.

11 * Sec. 3. (a) The repeal of the permanent fund dividend program in
12 this Act does not affect

13 (1) the right to a permanent fund dividend based on sec. 19, ch.
14 102, SLA 1982; or

15 (2) the continued accumulation of income available for dis-
16 tribution as set out in AS 37.13.140 - 37.13.145.

17 (b) The repeal of the permanent fund dividend program in this Act
18 precludes the distribution of permanent fund dividends for the year 1983
19 and following years.

20 * Sec. 4. AS 09.20.050(b) is amended to read:

21 (b) The jury list shall be based on a list of all persons who
22 purchased a resident trapping, hunting or fishing license during the
23 preceding calendar year which showed an Alaskan address (to be pre-
24 pared by the Department of Fish and Game), [A LIST OF ALL PERSONS WHO
25 FILED FOR A DISTRIBUTION OF ALASKA PERMANENT FUND INCOME UNDER AS 43.-
26 23 DURING THE PRECEDING CALENDAR YEAR WHICH SHOWED AN ALASKAN ADDRESS
27 (TO BE PREPARED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE),] a list of all persons
28 who have registered to vote in this state (to be prepared by the
29 director of elections), and, if considered necessary by the

1 administrative director of courts, a list of all persons who hold a
2 valid Alaska drivers' license (to be prepared by the Department of
3 Public Safety). The departments and the director of elections shall
4 submit their respective lists to the Department of Administration not
5 later than January 15 of each year. To the extent that it is avail-
6 able, the lists submitted by the departments and the director of
7 elections shall contain the following information for each person on
8 the list for the preceding calendar year: first name, middle initial,
9 and last name; residence address as well as mailing address, including
10 the zip code for each; birth date; and the number of years and months
11 the person has been a resident of the state. The lists submitted by
12 the departments and the director of elections shall be recorded on
13 magnetic tape compatible with Department of Administration data pro-
14 cessing equipment.

15 * Sec. 5. Sections 1 - 3 of this Act are retroactive to January 1,
16 1983.

17 * Sec. 6. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.-
18 10.070(c).
