6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to state aid to municipalities for
7 animal control; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 29.89 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 29.89.025. STATE AID TO MUNICIPALITIES FOR ANIMAL CONTROL.

11 (a) The department shall pay to an eligible municipality \$5 per
12 capita for each resident of the municipality to be used for animal
13 control.

14 (b) A municipality is eligible for a payment under this section
15 if the municipality

16 (1) has power to provide for licensing, impounding, and
17 disposition of animals and exercises that power; and

18 (2) agrees to spend an amount equal to 25 percent of the
19 payment for programs to inform the public of problems created by stray
20 animals and of the need for animal control.

21 * Sec. 2. AS 29.60 is amended by adding a new section to read:

22 Sec. 29.60.115. STATE AID TO MUNICIPALITIES FOR ANIMAL CONTROL.

23 (a) The department shall pay to an eligible municipality \$5 per
24 capita for each resident of the municipality to be used for animal
25 control.

26 (b) A municipality is eligible for a payment under this section
27 if the municipality

28 (1) has power to provide for licensing, impounding, and
29 disposition of animals and exercises that power; and

1 (2) agrees to spend an amount equal to 25 percent of the
2 payment for programs to inform the public of problems created by stray
3 animals and of the need for animal control.

4 * Sec. 3. The payments authorized under AS 29.60.115 added by sec. 2 of
5 this Act may not be paid until the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1983.

6 * Sec. 4. AS 29.89.025 as enacted in sec. 1 of this Act is repealed.

7 * Sec. 5. Section 1 of this Act takes effect July 1, 1983.

8 * Sec. 6. Sections 2 - 4 of this Act take effect on the effective date
9 of a version of an Act revising AS 29 passed by the Thirteenth Legislature
10 and enacted into law.
