A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act exempting certain real property from municipi-
7 pal taxation; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 29.53.020(a) is amended by adding a new paragraph to
10 read:

11 (9) real property, not exceeding \$100,000 in assessed
12 value, owned and occupied as a permanent place of abode by a resident
13 under 65 years of age.

14 * Sec. 2. AS 29.53.020(i) is amended to read:

15 (i) In (a)(9) and (e) - (i) of this section the term "real
16 property" includes but is not limited to mobile homes, whether clas-
17 sified as real or personal property for municipal tax purposes.

18 * Sec. 3. AS 29.45.030(a) is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

19 (8) real property, not exceeding \$100,000 in assessed
20 value, owned and occupied as a permanent place of abode by a resident
21 under 65 years of age.

22 * Sec. 4. AS 29.45.030(i) is amended to read:

23 (i) In (a)(8) and (e) - (i) of this section "real property"
24 includes but is not limited to mobile homes, whether classified as
25 real or personal property for municipal tax purposes.

26 * Sec. 5. The property tax exemption provided for in AS 29.45.030(a)(8)
27 enacted in sec. 3 of this Act begins January 1, 1984.

28 * Sec. 6. Sections 1 and 2 of this Act are repealed.

29 * Sec. 7. Sections 1 and 2 of this Act take effect January 1, 1984.

1 * Sec. 8. Sections 3 - 6 of this Act take effect on the effective date
2 of a version of an Act revising AS 29 passed by the Thirteenth Legislature
3 and enacted into law.
