6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to state aid to municipalities for
7 roads; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 29.89.020(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) The department shall pay to a municipality that [WHICH] has
11 power to provide for road maintenance and exercises that power, \$3,500
12 [\$2,500] a mile for each mile of road, street or highway maintained by
13 the municipality [LOCAL GOVERNMENT], excluding (1) the official state
14 highway system, (2) roads, streets or highways not dedicated to public
15 use, (3) roads, streets or highways maintained under the local service
16 road program (AS 19.30.111 - 19.30.251), and (4) alleyways, in accor-
17 dance with regulations adopted by the Department of Transportation and
18 Public Facilities. A payment may not be made under this subsection
19 for maintenance of a road that [WHICH] is not used by automotive
20 equipment.

21 * Sec. 2. AS 29.60.110(a) is amended to read:

22 (a) The department shall pay to a municipality that has power to
23 provide for road maintenance and exercises that power \$3,500 [\$2,500]
24 a mile for each mile of road, street, or highway maintained by the
25 municipality, excluding (1) the official state highway system, (2)
26 roads, streets, or highways not dedicated to public use, (3) roads,
27 streets, or highways maintained under the local service road program
28 (AS 19.30.111 - 19.30.251), and (4) alleyways, in accordance with
29 regulations adopted by the Department of Transportation and Public

1 Facilities. A payment may not be made under this subsection for
2 maintenance of a road that is not used by automotive equipment.

3 * Sec. 3. Payments of state aid authorized in sec. 2 of this Act shall
4 start during the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1983.

5 * Sec. 4. Section 1 of this Act is repealed.

6 * Sec. 5. Section 1 of this Act takes effect July 1, 1983,

7 * Sec. 6. Sections 2 - 4 of this Act take effect on the effective date
8 of a version of an Act revising AS 29 passed by the Thirteenth Legislature
9 and enacted into law.
