6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the determination of population  
7 for purposes of calculating amounts of state aid; and  
8 providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 29.88.015 is amended by adding a new subsection to  
11 read:

12 (c) The population of the taxing unit does not include an indi-  
13 vidual who is employed in the taxing unit but whose primary place of  
14 residence is outside the taxing unit, regardless of the amount of time  
15 that individual spends in the taxing unit.

16 \* Sec. 2. AS 29.89.060 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

17 (b) A population determination under this section may not in-  
18 clude an individual who is employed in the area for which the deter-  
19 mination is made but whose primary place of residence is outside the  
20 area, regardless of the amount of time that individual spends in the  
21 area.

22 \* Sec. 3. AS 29.60.020 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

23 (b) The population of the taxing unit does not include an indi-  
24 vidual who is employed in the taxing unit but whose primary place of  
25 residence is outside the taxing unit, regardless of the amount of time  
26 that individual spends in the taxing unit.

27 \* Sec. 4. AS 29.50.130 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

28 (b) A population determination under this section may not in-  
29 clude an individual who is employed in the area for which the

1       determination is made but whose primary place of residence is outside  
2       the area, regardless of the amount of time that individual spends in  
3       the area.

4       \* Sec. 5. Sections 3 and 4 of this Act shall be used to calculate  
5       amounts of state aid beginning July 1, 1983.

6       \* Sec. 6. Sections 1 and 2 of this Act are repealed.

7       \* Sec. 7. Sections 1 and 2 of this Act take effect July 1, 1983.

8       \* Sec. 8. Sections 3 - 6 of this Act take effect on the effective date  
9       of a version of an Act revising AS 29 passed by the Thirteenth Legislature  
10       and enacted into law.
