A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the public employees' retirement
7 system and the teachers' retirement system; and
8 providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 14.25 is amended by adding a new section to read:

11 Sec. 14.25.095. CREDIT FOR SERVICE UNDER THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES'
12 RETIREMENT SYSTEM. (a) Notwithstanding other provisions of this
13 chapter, a member may claim credited service under this system for all
14 credited service earned by the member under the public employees'
15 retirement system (AS 39.35).

16 (b) A member who receives credited service under (a) of this
17 section may not receive credit for the same service under the public
18 employees' retirement system.

19 * Sec. 2. AS 14.25.220(10) is amended to read:

20 (10) "credited service" means all membership service as
21 provided in (20) of this section, territorial employment as defined in
22 (41) of this section, plus outside, military, public employee, and
23 Alaska BIA service, with outside and military service limited to 10
24 years except under the conditions set out in AS 14.25.100;

25 * Sec. 3. AS 39.35.300(a) is amended to read:

26 (a) An active employee is entitled to credited service for
27 periods of employment with the state after January 1, 1961, regardless
28 of the office, department, division, or agency of the state in which
29 [HE WAS] employed. [FOR PURPOSES OF THIS CHAPTER, THE UNIVERSITY OF

1 ALASKA IS NOT AN OFFICE, DEPARTMENT, DIVISION, OR AGENCY OF THE STATE.
2 SERVICE CREDIT MAY NOT BE GRANTED UNDER THIS CHAPTER FOR SERVICE WHICH
3 IS CREDITABLE UNDER THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM, AS 14.25.]

4 * Sec. 4. AS 39.35 is amended by adding a new section to read:

5 Sec. 39.35.315. CREDIT FOR SERVICE UNDER TEACHERS' RETIREMENT
6 SYSTEM. An active employee is entitled to credited service for all
7 credited service earned by the member under the teachers' retirement
8 system (AS 14.25). An employee who claims credited service under this
9 section may not receive credit for the same service under the teach-
10 ers' retirement system.

11 * Sec. 5. This Act takes effect July 1, 1983.
