6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to disclosure of vital statistics
7 records and information; and providing for an
8 effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 18.50.310(a) is amended to read:

11 (a) To protect the integrity of vital statistics records, to
12 insure their proper use, and to insure the efficient and proper admini-
13 tration of the vital statistics system, it is unlawful for a person to
14 permit inspection of, or to disclose information contained in vital
15 statistics records, or to copy or issue a copy of all or part of a
16 record, except as provided by this section or as authorized by
17 regulations issued under this chapter.

18 * Sec. 2. AS 18.50.310 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

19 (f) When 100 years have elapsed after the date of birth, or 50
20 years have elapsed after the date of death, marriage, or divorce, dis-
21 solution of marriage, or annulment, the records of these events in the
22 custody of the state registrar become public records subject to the
23 provisions of AS 09.25.110 - 09.25.125.

24 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10
25 070(c).
