5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act making appropriations for the operating and
7 capital expenses of state government; and providing
8 for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. Included within the general fund amounts appropriated
11 according to the schedules in this Act, the following amounts are from the
12 unreserved special accounts in the general fund:

13 Highway Fuel Tax Account	\$19,500,000	
14 Aviation Fuel Tax Account	9,100,000	
15 Watercraft Fuel Tax Account		\$4,000,000

16 * Sec. 2. A sum is appropriated from the general fund necessary to pay
17 interest on revenue anticipation notes issued by the commissioner of reve-
18 nue under AS 43.08.010.

19 * Sec. 3. Federal or other program receipts that exceed the amounts
20 appropriated in this Act are appropriated conditioned upon compliance with
21 the program review provisions of AS 37.07.080(h).

22 * Sec. 4. If federal or other program receipts exceed the estimates
23 appropriated by this Act, the appropriation from state funds for the af-
24 fected program may be reduced by the amount of the excess if the reductions
25 are not inconsistent with applicable federal statutes.

26 * Sec. 5. If program receipts fall short of the estimates appropriated
27 by this Act, the affected appropriation shall be reduced by the amount of
28 the shortfall in receipts.
29

1 * Sec. 6. If the federal receipts under Title XX of the Social Security
2 Act (42 U.S.C. 1397 et seq.) fall short of the estimate, the amount of the
3 shortfall is appropriated from the general fund.

4 * Sec. 7. Amounts equivalent to the amounts to be received in settle-
5 ment of insurance claims for property losses are appropriated from the
6 general fund to the affected agency for the purpose of replacing the facil-
7 ity or service lost as a result of the incident giving rise to the insur-
8 ance claim.

9 * Sec. 8. A sum of \$30,000 is appropriated from the public employees'
10 retirement fund to the Department of Revenue, treasury division, for each
11 \$10,000,000 or portion of \$10,000,000 of public employees' retirement fund
12 assets measured at market under outside investment management during fiscal
13 year 1984 in excess of the amount of assets measured at market under out-
14 side investment management on June 30, 1983.

15 * Sec. 9. A sum of \$30,000 is appropriated from the teachers' retire-
16 ment fund to the Department of Revenue, treasury division, for each
17 \$10,000,000 or portion of \$10,000,000 of teachers' retirement fund assets
18 measured at market under outside investment management during fiscal year
19 1984 in excess of the amount of assets measured at market under outside
20 investment management on June 30, 1983.

21 * Sec. 10. The amount required to be paid by the state for the princi-
22 pal and interest on all issued and outstanding state guaranteed bonds is
23 appropriated from the general fund to the state bond committee to make all
24 payments by the state required under its guarantee for principal and inter-
25 est.

26 * Sec. 11. The sum of \$11,222,700 is appropriated from the general fund
27 to the Department of Law to fund legal proceedings involving oil and gas
28 revenues due or paid to the state or state title to oil and gas lands,
29 including the North Slope Royalty case (State v. Amerada Hess, et al), the

1 Oil and Gas Corporate Income Tax Case (Arco v. State), the TransAlaska
2 Pipeline Rate Case, litigation against the Alaska Oil Company, and United
3 States v. Alaska, for fiscal year 1984 and succeeding fiscal years.

4 * Sec. 12. The sum of \$337,100 is appropriated from the general fund to
5 the Department of Revenue for costs associated with the Oil and Gas Corpo-
6 rate Income Tax Case (Arco v. State) for fiscal year 1984 and succeeding
7 fiscal years.

8 * Sec. 13. The sum of \$561,700 is appropriated from the general fund to
9 the Office of the Governor, office of management and budget to pay settle-
10 ments reached with the marine transportation bargaining units.

11 * Sec. 14. The sum of \$100,000 is appropriated from the general fund to
12 the the University of Alaska at Anchorage, school of health sciences for
13 the graduate nursing program.

14 * Sec. 15. The sum of \$93,750,000 is appropriated from the Permanent
15 Fund undistributed account (AS 37.13.145) to the Department of Education
16 for school bond debt retirement.

17 * Sec. 16. The sum of \$6,801,000 is appropriated from the general fund
18 to the Alaska Housing Finance Corporation for the special mortgage loan
19 purchase program (AS 18.56.098).

20 * Sec. 17. The sum of \$22,750,000 is appropriated from the general fund
21 to the Alaska Housing Finance Corporation for the home ownership assistance
22 program (AS 18.56.091).

23 * Sec. 18. The sum of \$16,800,000 is appropriated from the small busi-
24 ness loan fund (AS 45.95.010) to the Alaska Housing Finance Corporation for
25 the home ownership assistance program (AS 18.56.091).

26 * Sec. 19. The sum of \$2,700,000 is appropriated from the tourism
27 revolving loan fund (AS 45.90.010) to the Alaska Housing Finance Corpo-
28 ration for the home ownership assistance program (AS 18.56.091).

29 * Sec. 20. The sum of \$10,000,000 is appropriated from the general fund

1 to the division of housing assistance in the Department of Community and
2 Regional Affairs for grants made from the senior citizens housing develop-
3 ment fund for senior citizen housing facilities and for nonhousing facil-
4 ities that are incidental or appurtenant to senior citizen housing.

5 * Sec. 21. The sum of \$3,500,000 is appropriated from the general fund
6 to the supplemental housing development fund in the Department of Community
7 and Regional Affairs (AS 18.55.998).

8 * Sec. 22. The sum of \$45,000,000 is appropriated from the general fund
9 to the housing assistance loan fund in the Department of Community and
10 Regional Affairs for non-conforming, rural, and non-owner occupied housing
11 loans (AS 44.47.36 - 44.47.560).

12 * Sec. 23. The sum of \$22,483,900 is appropriated from the general fund
13 to the division of investments, Department of Commerce and Economic Devel-
14 opment, for the following purposes in the following amounts:

15 alternative technology and energy loan

16 program (AS 45.88) \$2,400,000

17 commercial fishing loan program (AS 16.10.-

18 300 - 16.10.370) 9,091,000

19 child care facility loan program (AS 44.33.240) 869,500

20 historical district loan program (AS 45.98) 500,000

21 fisheries enhancement loan program (AS 16.10.500) 6,500,000

22 residential energy conservation loan program

23 (AS 45.89) 3,123,400

24 * Sec. 24. The sum of \$10,000,000 is appropriated from the general fund
25 to the Department of Natural Resources for loans from the agricultural
26 revolving loan fund (AS 03.10.040).

27 * Sec. 25. The sum of \$60,000,000 is appropriated from the Permanent
28 Fund undistributed account (AS 37.13.145) to the scholarship revolving loan
29 fund (AS 14.40.751) for the student loan program.

1 * Sec. 26. The sum of \$850,000 in federal program receipts for student
2 loans and scholarships is appropriated to the scholarship revolving loan
3 fund (AS 14.40.751) for the student loan program.

4 * Sec. 27. The sum of \$1,000,000 is appropriated from the general fund
5 to the rural electrification revolving loan fund (AS 44.83.361) for rural
6 electrification loans.

7 * Sec. 28. The appropriations made by this Act are for the capi-
8 talization of loan and grant funds and do not lapse in accordance with
9 AS 37.25.010.

10 * Sec. 29. Sections 1 - 5 and 8 - 13 of this Act take effect immedi-
11 ately in accordance with AS 01.10.070(c).
