BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 44.12.010 is amended to read:

Sec. 44.12.010. LEGAL HOLIDAYS. The following days are legal

11

holidays: (1) the first of January, known as New Year's Day; (2) the

12th of February, known as Lincoln's Birthday; (3) the 22nd of [THIRD

MONDAY IN] February, known as Washington's Birthday; (4) the 30th

14

[LAST MONDAY] of March, known as Seward's Day; (5) the 30th of [LAST

15

MONDAY IN] May, known as Memorial Day; (6) the fourth of July, known

16

as Independence Day; (7) the first Monday in September, known as Labor

17

Day; (8) the eighteenth of October, known as Alaska Day; (9) the 11th

18

of November, known as Veterans' Day; (10) the fourth Thursday in

19

November, known as Thanksgiving Day; (11) the 25th of December, known

20

as Christmas Day; (12) every Sunday; (13) every day designated by

21

public proclamation by the President of the United States or the

22

governor of the state as a legal holiday.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1983.
