A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act restricting cost items that may be allowed in
7 public utility rates."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 42.05.381(a) is repealed and reenacted to read:

10 (a) All rates demanded or received by a public utility, or by
11 any two or more public utilities jointly, for a service furnished or
12 to be furnished for profit shall be just and reasonable. However, a
13 rate may not include an allowance for the costs of

14 (1) political contributions;

15 (2) lobbying;

16 (3) public relations;

17 (4) advertising;

18 (5) consulting or management fees paid to the owner of the
19 public utility or to a subsidiary or affiliate of the owner;

20 (6) products purchased from the owner of the public utility
21 or from a subsidiary or affiliate of the owner, in excess of the
22 actual value of the products; or

23 (7) services purchased from the owner of the public utility
24 or from a subsidiary or affiliate of the owner.
