6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the creation of an Alternate Name
7 Commission."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 44.19 is amended by adding new sections to read:

10 ARTICLE 17. ALTERNATE NAME COMMISSION.

11 Sec. 44.19.195. PURPOSE. The purpose of this Act is to provide
12 the means of considering suggestions for the changing of names of
13 positions, occupations, institutions, organizations, and agencies in
14 this state when more descriptive or appropriate names would result in
15 better understanding or when a financial savings to the state might
16 result from the use of a more professional title.

17 Sec. 44.19.196. ESTABLISHMENT OF AN ALTERNATE NAME COMMISSION.
18 The governor may establish an Alternate Name Commission and may ap-
19 point three unpaid commissioners.

20 Sec. 44.19.197. STAFF. The Alternate Name Commission may not
21 have a paid staff.

22 Sec. 44.19.198. RECOMMENDATIONS. The Alternate Name Commission
23 may recommend to the governor alternate names for positions, occupa-
24 tions, institutions, organizations, and agencies in this state.

25 Sec. 44.19.199. EFFECT OF ACCEPTANCE OF ALTERNATE NAME. Upon
26 acceptance by the governor of a recommended name, that name may be
27 used as a legal alternative to the existing name.
