6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to day care assistance for parents  
7 of developmentally disabled children."  
8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:  
9 \* Section 1. AS 44.47.310(3) is amended to read:  
10 (3) "child" means a [ANY] person below 11 years of age, or  
11 a minor who has a developmental disability;  
12 \* Sec. 2. AS 44.47.310 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:  
13 (7) "developmental disability" means a disability that  
14 (A) is attributable to  
15 (i) mental retardation, cerebral palsy, epilepsy,  
16 or autism;  
17 (ii) any other condition found to be closely  
18 related to mental retardation because the condition results  
19 in impairment of general intellectual functioning or adap-  
20 tive behavior similar to impairment resulting from mental  
21 retardation; or  
22 (iii) dyslexia resulting from a disability de-  
23 scribed in (i) or (ii) of this subparagraph; and  
24 (B) constitutes a substantial handicap to the person's  
25 ability to function normally in society.
