6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to tampering with an item that is a
7 food, drug, or cosmetic and delivering, dispensing,
8 or distributing those items."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 11.46.480(a) is amended by adding a new paragraph to
11 read:

12 (4) with intent to cause physical injury to another person,
13 the person:

14 (A) tampers with an item that is a food, drug, or
15 cosmetic or a container for the item; or

16 (B) delivers, dispenses, or distributes an item de-
17 scribed in (A) of this paragraph knowing that a person has tam-
18 pered with the item.

19 * Sec. 2. AS 11.46.480 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

20 (c) For purposes of (a)(4) of this section,

21 (1) "deliver" means the actual, constructive, or attempted
22 transfer from one person to another of an item;

23 (2) "dispense" means to deliver a drug to an ultimate user
24 or research subject by or under the lawful order of a practitioner,
25 including the prescribing, administering, packaging, labeling, or
26 compounding necessary to prepare the drug for that delivery;

27 (3) "distribute" means to deliver an item, whether or not
28 there is any money or other item of value exchanged; it includes sale,
29 gift, or exchange;

1 (4) "drug" has the meaning given in AS 11.71.900(9).

2 (5) "tamper" means to interfere with something improperly,
3 meddle with it, or make unwarranted alternations to its existing
4 condition.
