6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to public records."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 09.25.110 is amended to read:

Sec. 09.25.110. INSPECTION AND COPIES OF PUBLIC RECORDS. Unless
10 specifically provided otherwise the books, records, papers, files,
11 accounts, writings, and transactions of all agencies and departments,
12 including the names and addresses of subscribers of municipally owned
13 public telephone utilities and the phone numbers of those subscribers
14 who have not requested that their phone number be unlisted, are public
15 records and are open to inspection by the public under reasonable
16 rules during regular office hours. The public officer having the
17 custody of public records shall give on request and payment of costs a
18 certified copy of the public record. If a certified copy is not re-
19 quested, a public officer may not charge a fee that exceeds the actual
20 costs of searching for and copying the public records requested under
21 this section or AS 09.25.120.
