A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the regulation of the practice of
7 medicine."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 08.01.050 is amended by adding a new subsection to
10 read:

11 (c) After approval by the State Medical Board (AS 08.64.010),
12 the department shall employ an individual who is not a member of the
13 State Medical Board to be assigned as the investigator for that board.
14 The investigator shall

15 (1) conduct investigations into alleged violations of
16 AS 08.64, and into alleged violations of regulations and orders of the
17 State Medical Board;

18 (2) at the request of the State Medical Board, conduct
19 investigations based on complaints filed with the department or with
20 the board; and

21 (3) be directly responsible and accountable to the State
22 Medical Board, with the exception that only the department has author-
23 ity to terminate the investigator's employment.

24 * Sec. 2. AS 08.64 is amended by adding a new section to read:

25 Sec. 08.64.075. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE BOARD. After approval
26 by the board, the department shall employ a person who is not a member
27 of the board to serve as the executive director of the board. The
28 executive director shall

29 (1) perform the administrative duties required by the

1 department, by the board, and by this chapter;

2 (2) carry out regulations and policies of the board; and

3 (3) assist the board in conducting continuing education
4 programs and examinations of applicants for licenses.
