8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 21.36.090 is amended by adding a new subsection to

10 read:

11 (d) A person may not practice or permit discrimination against a  
12 person who provides a service covered under a group disability policy  
13 that extends coverage on an expense incurred basis, or under a group  
14 service or indemnity type contract issued by a nonprofit corporation,  
15 if the service is within the scope of the provider's occupational  
16 license. In this subsection, "provider" means a state licensed physi-  
17 cian, dentist, osteopath, optometrist, chiropractor, nurse midwife and  
18 midwife.

19 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 1984.
