6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the licensing of salmon fishing  
7 guides."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 08.54 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 08.54.147. QUALIFICATIONS FOR SALMON FISHING GUIDE LICENSE.

11 A person who meets the qualifications established by regulation of the  
12 board is entitled to be licensed as a salmon fishing guide.
