A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the creation of the World War II  
7 History Commission; and providing for an effective  
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. WORLD WAR II HISTORY COMMISSION ESTABLISHED. There is  
11 created in the Office of the Governor the World War II History Commission.  
12 The purpose of the commission is to gather and make available to the public  
13 films, documents, and other materials commemorating the participation of  
14 Alaska in World War II.

15 \* Sec. 2. MEMBERSHIP AND TERM OF OFFICE. The commission consists of  
16 five Alaskans who are veterans of World War II. Members of the commission  
17 are appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the governor.

18 \* Sec. 3. COMPENSATION. Members of the commission receive no compensa-  
19 tion for their services but are entitled to per diem and travel allowances  
20 authorized by law for other boards and commissions.

21 \* Sec. 4. DUTIES. The commission shall

22 (1) cooperate with public and private agencies to gather infor-  
23 mation and documents concerning the participation of Alaska in World War  
24 II;

25 (2) preserve the materials gathered and make them available to  
26 the public;

27 (3) expend the funds appropriated to the commission to carry out  
28 the purposes of this Act;

29 (4) report annually to the legislature and the governor the

1 activities of the commission; and

2 (5) perform all acts necessary to carry out the purposes of this  
3 Act.

4 \* Sec. 5. DEFINITION. In this Act "commission" means the World War II  
5 History Commission.

6 \* Sec. 6. This Act is repealed June 30, 1986.

7 \* Sec. 7. This Act takes effect July 1, 1984.
