For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for prisoner of war special regis-

tration plates."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 28.10.181 is amended by adding a new subsection to

10 read;

(1) Vehicles owned by former prisoners of war. The department,

12

upon receipt of written proof, may issue without charge to a prisoner

13

of war of World War I, World War II, the Korean conflict, and the

14

Vietnamese conflict, special registration plates for one noncommercial

15

motor vehicle. The design and color of the prisoner of war plates

16

shall be solely within the discretion of the commissioner.

(d) The special registration fees under this subsection are

imposed annually, unless otherwise specified, for:

(1) an historic vehicle (one time only upon initial regis-

tration under AS 28.10.181) \$10;

section; the fee required by this paragraph shall be collected only on
