A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to a motor vehicle infraction for
7 disobeying a traffic control device and providing for
8 a minimum fine."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 28.35 is amended by adding a new section to read:

11 Sec. 28.35.047. DISOBEYING OFFICIAL TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICE. (a)
12 A person may not drive a motor vehicle in disregard of instructions of
13 an applicable official traffic-control device placed and displayed in
14 accordance with the provisions of statutes, regulations, or ordinances
15 unless otherwise directed by a police officer or other authorized
16 person directing traffic, and except as provided by law or regulation
17 for emergency vehicles.

18 (b) A person convicted of disobeying an official traffic control
19 device under (a) of this section is guilty of an infraction under
20 AS 28.35.230 and is subject to a fine of not more than \$50.

21 (c) In this section "official traffic control device" means a
22 sign or signal placed or erected by authority of a state or municipal
23 agency or official having jurisdiction for the purpose of traffic
24 regulation or warning.
