A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to claims against a contractor's
7 payment bond."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 36.25.020(b) is amended to read:

10 (b) However, a person having direct contractual relationships
11 with a subcontractor but no contractual relationship express or
12 implied with the contractor furnishing the payment bond has a right of
13 action on the payment bond upon giving written notice to the contrac-
14 tor within 10 [90] days from the first [LAST] date on which the person
15 performed labor or furnished material for which the claim is made.
16 The notice shall [MUST] state [WITH SUBSTANTIAL ACCURACY THE AMOUNT
17 CLAIMED AND] the name of the person to whom the material was furnished
18 or for whom the labor was performed, identify the public building
19 project or public work project for which the material was furnished or
20 for which the labor was performed, describe the material furnished and
21 to be furnished or the work performed and to be performed, and state
22 the date on which the material was first furnished or the work was
23 first performed. The notice shall be served by mailing it by regis-
24 tered mail, postage prepaid, in an envelope addressed to the contrac-
25 tor at any place where the contractor maintains an office or conducts
26 business, or the contractor's residence, or in any manner in which a
27 peace officer is authorized to serve summons.
