8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
9 * Section 1. AS 14.20.207(1) is amended to read:
10 (1) "teacher" means a person serving in a teaching, coun-
11 seling, or administrative capacity and required to be certificated in
12 order to hold the position; or a Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps
13 instructor who is responsible for student supervision and instruction,
14 has direct student contact for five or more hours a day, and is certi-
15 ficated;
16 * Sec. 2. AS 14.25.220(38) is amended to read:
17 (38) "teacher or member" means a person eligible to partici-
18 pate in the system and who is covered by the system, including:
19 (A) a certificated full-time or part-time elementary
20 or secondary teacher, a certificated school nurse, a Junior
21 Reserve Officer Training Corps instructor who is responsible for
22 student supervision and instruction, has direct student contact
23 for five or more hours a day, and is certificated, or a certifi-
24 cated person in a position requiring a teaching certificate as a
25 condition of employment in a public school of the state;
26 (B) the commissioner of education and all supervisory
27 positions in the Department of Education;
28 (C) a full-time or part-time teacher of the University
29 of Alaska or a person occupying a full-time administrative

1 position at the University of Alaska which requires academic
2 standing; the approval of the administrator must be obtained
3 before an administrative position qualifies for membership in the
4 system;

5 (D) a state legislator who elects membership under
6 AS 14.25.040(b);
