(5) "project" means

(A) a plant or facility used or intended for use in

connection with making, processing, preparing, or producing in

any manner, goods, products or substances of any kind or nature

or in connection with developing or utilizing a natural resource,

or extracting, smelting, transporting, converting, assembling or

producing in any manner, minerals, raw materials, chemicals,

compounds, alloys, fibers, commodities and materials, products or

substances of any kind or nature, any plant or facility used or

intended for use as an industrial park or in connection with air

25

and water transportation, or any plant or facility for the pre-

26

vention, limitation or control of air or water pollution, for the

27

disposal of sewage or solid waste, for the local furnishing of

gas, or for the furnishing of water;

(B) a plant or facility used or intended for use in

1 connection with a business enterprise;

2 (C) commercial activity by a small enterprise;

3 (D) a public service facility including a

4 (i) student, cooperative, or other nonprofit
5 housing facility;

6 (ii) social services facility;

7 (iii) school, pre-school, or nursery facility;

8 (iv) clinic or health center; or

9 (v) multi-purpose community center;

10 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 1984.
