6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to reports by school district

employees of certain acts committed by students."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 14.20 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 14.20.115. SCHOOL DISTRICT EMPLOYEES REQUIRED TO REPORT

11

CERTAIN OFFENSES BY STUDENTS. (a) If, in the course of employment, a

12

teacher or other school district employee witnesses a student on

13

school grounds committing an act causing serious physical injury or

14

possessing a dangerous instrument or a controlled substance, as

15

defined in AS 11.81.900, the teacher or school district employee shall

16

report the act or possession to the law enforcement agency having

17

jurisdiction for the area in which the school is located.

18

(b) A teacher or school district employee required to make a

19

report under this section shall make the report within 24 hours of

20

witnessing the act or possession or as soon as practicable.

(c) Failure to make a timely report required under this section

22

is a class B misdemeanor.
