6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to permits for games of chance and  
7 contests of skill; and providing for an effective  
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 05.15.210(19) is amended to read:

11 (19) "qualified organization" means a bona fide civic or  
12 service organization or a bona fide religious, charitable, fraternal,  
13 labor, political, or educational organization, police or fire  
14 department company, dog mushers' association, outboard motor  
15 association, or fishing-derby or nonprofit trade association in the  
16 state, which operates without profits to its members and which has  
17 been in existence continually for a period of five years immediately  
18 before applying for a license; the commissioner may adopt regulations  
19 to waive the five-year requirement if the organization is associated  
20 with an organization that meets the five-year requirement and the  
21 commissioner determines that the organization will comply with the  
22 requirements and purposes of this chapter; the organization may be a  
23 firm, corporation, company, association or partnership;
