6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to video machine lotteries conducted
7 by municipalities."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 05.15.100 is amended by adding a new subsection to
10 read:

11 (c) The commissioner of revenue may issue a permit giving a
12 municipality the privilege of conducting video machine lotteries. A
13 person under the age of 18 may not participate in a video machine
14 lottery. A permit may only be issued for the use of a video machine
15 that produces a printed copy for each winning player indicating the

16 (1) amount of the cash prize or description of the item
17 won;

18 (2) date the prize is won;

19 (3) serial number of the machine; and

20 (4) location of the machine.

21 * Sec. 2. AS 05.15.180(a) is amended to read:

22 (a) Except as provided in AS 05.15.100(b) and (c), this chapter
23 does not authorize the use of playing cards, dice, roulette wheels,
24 coin-operated instruments or machines, or other objects or instruments
25 used, designed, or intended primarily for gaming or gambling or any
26 other method or implement not expressly authorized by the commis-
27 sioner.

28 * Sec. 3. AS 05.15.180(b) is amended to read:

29 (b) With the exception of raffles, lotteries, raffle classics, and

1 other activities authorized under AS 05.15.100(b) and (c), no activity
2 may be licensed under this chapter unless it existed in the state in
3 substantially the same form and was conducted in substantially the
4 same manner before January 1, 1959.
