6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to crimes against a dependent
7 person."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 12.55.155(c) is amended by adding a new paragraph to
10 read:

11 (27) the defendant is convicted of an offense specified in
12 AS 11.46 and the offense was committed against a person who, because
13 of a mental disability attributable to a birth defect, physical dis-
14 order, or advanced age, is unable to properly provide for the person's
15 own personal needs, including physical health, food, clothing, or
16 shelter, or is substantially unable to manage the person's own finan-
17 cial resources or to resist fraud or undue influence.
