A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act prohibiting the removal of World War II
7 artifacts from state land."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 11.76 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 11.76.130. REMOVING WORLD WAR II ARTIFACTS. (a) A person
11 commits the crime of removing World War II artifacts if the person

12 (1) intentionally removes from state land a vehicle, air-
13 craft, watercraft or weapon used during World War II for the purpose
14 of conducting the war; and

15 (2) the removal is not authorized by the federal government
16 or state government.

17 (b) Removing World War II artifacts is a class B misdemeanor.
