7 Utilities Commission; and providing for an effective

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 42.05.221(e) is amended to read:

11 (e) The commission may employ professional consultants to assist  
12 it in administering the provisions of this section and may apportion  
13 the expenses relating to this administration among the competing  
14 utilities, as set out in AS 42.05.651 [INVOLVED].

15 \* Sec. 2. AS 42.05.651 is amended to read:

16 Sec. 42.05.651. EXPENSES OF INVESTIGATION OR HEARING. During or  
17 after [AFTER COMPLETION OF] a hearing or investigation held under this  
18 chapter, the commission shall allocate the costs of the hearing or  
19 investigation among the parties, including the commission, as is just  
20 under the circumstances. In allocating costs, the commission may  
21 consider the results, ability to pay, evidence of good faith, other  
22 relevant factors and mitigating circumstances. The costs allocated  
23 may include the costs of any time devoted to the investigation or  
24 hearing by hired consultants, the commission's professional staff, and  
25 the attorney general or other legal counsel for the commission, wheth-  
26 er or not they [THE CONSULTANTS] appear as witnesses or participants.  
27 The costs allocated may also include any out-of-pocket expenses in-  
28 curred by the commission in the particular proceeding. The commission  
29 shall provide an opportunity for any person objecting to an allocation

4 During a proceeding held under this chapter, the commission shall  
5 allocate the cost of the proceeding among the parties, including the

8 ings by hired consultants, the commission's professional staff, and

17 to investigations or hearings by hired consultants, the commission's  
18 professional staff, and the attorney general or other legal counsel  
19 for the commission, whether or not they [THE CONSULTANTS] appear as  
20 witnesses or participants. The commission shall provide an opportuni-  
21 ty for any person objecting to a reallocation to be heard before the  
22 reallocation becomes final.
