A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to marijuana; and providing for an
7 effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 11.71.060(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) Except as authorized in AS 17.30 or AS 17.35, a person
11 commits the crime of misconduct involving a controlled substance in
12 the sixth degree if the person

13 (1) uses or displays any amount of a schedule VIA con-
14 trolled substance or possesses one or more preparations, compounds,
15 mixtures, or substances of an aggregate weight of less than one-half
16 pound [ONE OUNCE OR MORE] containing a schedule VIA controlled sub-
17 stance [ON A PUBLIC STREET OR SIDEWALK OR ON THE PREMISES OF A PUBLIC
18 CARRIER OR BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENT OR IN ANY OTHER PUBLIC PLACE]; or

19 [(2) KNOWINGLY POSSESSES ANY AMOUNT OF A SCHEDULE VIA
20 CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE WITHIN THE IMMEDIATE CONTROL OF THAT PERSON WHILE
21 OPERATING A PROPELLED VEHICLE;

22 (3) BEING UNDER 19 YEARS OF AGE, POSSESSES ONE OR MORE
23 PREPARATIONS, COMPOUNDS, MIXTURES, OR SUBSTANCES OF AN AGGREGATE
24 WEIGHT OF LESS THAN FOUR OUNCES CONTAINING A SCHEDULE VIA CONTROLLED
25 SUBSTANCE;

26 (4) POSSESSES ONE OR MORE PREPARATIONS, COMPOUNDS, MIX-
27 TURES, OR SUBSTANCES OF AN AGGREGATE WEIGHT OF FOUR OUNCES OR MORE
28 CONTAINING A SCHEDULE VIA CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE; OR]

29 (2) [(5)] refuses entry into a premises for an inspection
