6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to automobile clubs."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 21.03.021 is amended by adding a new subsection to
9 read:

10 (b) This title does not apply to an automobile club organized
11 and operated without profit to any member for the purpose of providing
12 service to travelers, including emergency road service, the providing
13 of bail bonds for traffic offenses, reimbursement of legal fees for
14 representation on traffic offenses, providing maps and trip planning
15 services, or the arrangement of discounts, rebates or price reductions
16 on travel-related goods and services. However, all policies and
17 contracts issued by an automobile club shall provide for acceptance of
18 service of process within the state. The director may require an
19 automobile club to post with the department a bond in an amount not to
20 exceed \$50,000, issued by a corporate surety qualified under the laws
21 of the state to act as surety in furnishing bail, and conditioned upon
22 the organization's faithful fulfillment of its contracts within the
23 state.
