6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to minimum electrical standards."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 18.60.580 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 18.60.580. MINIMUM ELECTRICAL STANDARDS. The 1984 [1981]
10 published edition of the National Electrical Code (ANSI/NFPA) approved
11 by the American National Standards Institute on August 5, 1983
12 [ASSOCIATION,] and the 1984 [LATEST] published edition of the National
13 Electrical Safety Code (ANSI C2-1984) approved by the American
14 National Standards Institute on July 15, 1983 [ISSUED BY THE UNITED
15 STATES DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE, BUREAU OF STANDARDS], constitute the
16 minimum electrical safety standards of the state.

17 * Sec. 2. Notwithstanding the amendments to AS 18.60.580 in sec. 1 of
18 this Act, the minimum standard established by art. 336.2 of the 1981
19 National Electrical Code shall remain the minimum standard until December
20 31, 1984. On January 1, 1985 the minimum standard established by art.
21 336.2 of the 1984 National Electrical Code shall become the minimum
22 standard.
