5 Relating to displaying the flags of the
6 United States of America and the State
7 of Alaska.
8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
9 WHEREAS the display of the flag of the United States of America and
10 State of Alaska according to flag etiquette would do much to augment patri-
11 otism and act as a stirring reminder to elected officials and government
12 employees to do their duty for the state and the nation;
13 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests
14 the Governor to have the flag of the United States of America and the flag
15 of the State of Alaska displayed on the existing flag poles of all appro-
16 priate state office buildings according to AS 44.09.030; and be it
17 FURTHER RESOLVED that a maintenance or security person on duty seven
18 days a week, have the solemn duty to raise and lower the flags according to
19 flag etiquette and maintain the flags, fittings, and halyards in pristine
20 condition by respectful replacement, maintenance, and repair; and be it
21 FURTHER RESOLVED that the flags be flown from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
22 throughout the state because of the absence of sunrise and sunset in
23 northern localities during part of the winter.
